Date - 61 A.D., while Paul was in house arrest in Rome (Philip. 1:7, 13-14; Acts 28:16-31).

Theme - Thanking them for their generosity (Philip. 4:14-19; 2 Cor. 8:1-2; 11:9) and to encourage the church to press on to know the Lord in unity, humility, fellowship and peace. Jesus is the purpose of living.
